RANGITAIKI Station, Taupo

The beef progeny test at Rangitaiki involves 400 of the cows and all 380 heifers. A range of Angus bulls are being used, in line with the station's breeding cow policy. In addition - with the large number of cows and heifers available - some were mated to Hereford and Stabiliser bulls, as alternative maternal breeds, and some cows were mated to Simmental bulls, as a terminal sire option. Rangitaiki Station manager Sam Bunny is overseeing the B+LNZ Genetics Beef Progeny Test on the property, the dayto-day logistics are handled by sheep and beef manager Kevin Stewart and finishing cattle stock manager Tracy Gage-Brown.
